SOUTHERN PECAN PIES

Serves: 6 - 8

Ingredients:

- 3 eggs
- ½ c. brown sugar
- 4 T. melted butter
- 1 c. white corn syrup
- 1 t. vanilla extract
- 1/8 t. salt
- 1 c. chopped pecans

Directions:

- Beat eggs and sugar well.
- Add next 5 ingredients in order given
- Pour into 8-inch pie plate lined with a crust
- Bake at 350 degrees for 45 minutes on middle rack
- Let cool before attempting to slice into serving pieces
