SOUR CREAM BANANA BREAD

Serves: 8-10

Ingredients:

- ½ c. butter or canola oil
- ½ c. sour cream
- 1 c. sugar
- 2 eggs
- 1 t. vanilla
- 1 ½ c. flour
- 1 t. baking soda
- ½ t. salt
- 1 c. mashed bananas
- ½ c. chopped nuts

Directions:

- Butter loaf pans (1 large or 2 small).
- Cream butter, sugar, eggs, and vanilla.
- Add dry ingredients
- Add bananas, nuts, and sour cream
- Mix well
- Bake at 350 degrees for one hour (large loaf) or 45 minutes (small loaves)

EUGENE CLARK DIED FEB. 09, 2023

Gene Clark was born Feb. 20, 1947. He served his country in the US Air Force from 1969 to 1972. Following the Air Force, he taught at East Cobb Middle School. In 1978, he began practicing law in Marietta where he practiced for 34 years. He also served in the Ga. General Assembly, as a member of the House of Representatives from 1991-1992. He died Feb. 09, 2023. A funeral service was held on Feb. 15 at St. Clare of Assisi Catholic Church in Acworth. Interment was at Kennesaw Memorial Park cemetery in Marietta.
